Why do you have to fill in a ten-page form If you just want to renew your Blue Badge After three years. My friend helped me But she's partially blind and she had to fill out the form Using a magnifying glass. It's not very accessible. There were lots of irrelevant questions. But nothing has changed in the past years. It should be sent out every three years automatically.

I can use my Blue Badge when I go out In my friend's husband's car. We went to Morrisons today. We can park near, so you don't have too far to walk.

The person is the Blue Badge holder, Not the vehicle. You can use the Blue Badge In any car you go out in. You can even use it on a motorbike. Tricycle motorbikes and four wheel motorbikes Are suitable for people with a lot of disabilities.

My bus driver is called Sean and he has a blue badge. He drives a disability minibus. Sean gets annoyed when people park in the wrong space!
